

## Key Stage 4 Transition Evening Thursday 13th June 2024

The move into Year 10 signals an important and significant step in life for your child as they are now on the journey towards GCSE and Level 2 courses. In order to make this a successful transition, your child will need your support and guidance along that journey. We believe that a strong and cooperative school/home partnership is essential to ensure that potential is unlocked and that your child receives the best direction and encouragement possible.

Building on our foundation of collaboration, we would like to invite **parents and carers only** (students do not need to attend) to a **Key Stage 4 Transition Evening** on **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June at 6.00pm**. The evening will cover a variety of topics including useful information about the examination process as well as revision and study skills. The Heads of English, Maths and Science will also speak.

This is a particularly important step in the next stage of your child's progress and development and it builds on the success of our previous transition from Key Stage 2 to 3. Research has shown that students who receive structured parental support achieve more highly and are more motivated. ## Work Experience 2024

All students in Year 10 will complete a one-week work placement towards the end of the academic year, this is currently scheduled for the week beginning 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
