- The ship 'Resolute' and the rest of the centre and its facilities will be exclusively for the group - there will be no other groups onsite. Accommodation is in the form of 2 bunk beds per cabin. The cabins are spacious and all have en-suite facilities (shower, toilet and basin). Bedding is provided but guests are asked to bring their own duvet covers and pillow cases.

What will I need to take?

- Packed lunch for day 1
- Enough clothes & underwear for the stay (bearing in mind you are likely to get wet on activities and that it is generally 5% cooler on the water). No denim for activities
- 2 Two pairs of footwear, one to stay dry (trainers) and one to get wet e.g., old trainers/wetsuit shoes (NOT Crocs, wellies or flip flops - they must be securely attached to your feet)
- Indoor shoes/slippers for on board the ship (NO SHOES ON THE BOAT)
- Swimming kit
- Woollen hat or cap (depending on the time of year)
- Waterproof coat or jacket
- Large plastic bag for wet clothing and shoes
- Duvet cover and pillow case
- Towel and toiletries
- Spending money (we have a small gift shop), max cost of item is £6.
- Insect repellent (if applicable for the time of year)

What does it cost?

- £153.50

- This covers transport, accommodation, food (except packed lunch on day 1) activities, insurance
